## Recruiting Moravian College Economics and Business Students

The Economics and Business Department offers majors in Accounting, Economics, Management, and International Management. In addition to preparing students for various graduate programs, these majors provide a background that is valuable in a wide range of occupations in business, government and not-for-profit organizations.

The Accounting major helps prepare students for the CPA exam in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and other states and to enter public, private, or not-for-profit accounting positions. The Economics major provides a good background for careers in business and government as well as a foundation for graduate work in business, economics, law, public administration, planning, and other professional disciplines. The Management major provides a comprehensive background in the functional and environmental areas of business and serves as a basis for graduate study in business and management, as well as for immediate career preparation. The International Management major, which is offered in conjunction with the Foreign Language Department, prepares students for international careers in business or public administration.

### STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

Students may qualify for membership in Omicron Delta Epsilon, the international economics honor society. They may participate in numerous clubs related to economics and business, including the Accounting Club, the Economics & Business Club, the Moravian College Student Chapter of the Institute of Management Accountants (IMA), and the Amrhein Investment Club, which manages a fund of over \$1,000,000.
