

MORAVIAN COLLEGE FIRST-YEAR STUDENT VEHICLE POLICY

- Freshman are not permitted to have vehicles on campus.
- This policy is administered and enforced by the Department of Campus Safety and Police.
- The Parking Committee, under the direction of the Director of Campus Safety and Police, makes decisions on exceptions when the College is in session.
- When the College is not in session, decisions on exceptions are made by an ad hoc committee consisting of the Director of Campus Safety/Chief of Police, the VP for Student Affairs, and the Dean of Residence Life.
- Exceptions may be granted for the following reasons with noted document.

REASONS / DOCUMENTATION

Freshman are Granted an exception if they are registered for a class that requires them to have a car to get to their assignment: Student teaching experience, ROTC and Nursing. THERE ARE NO OTHER EXCEPTIONS.

Parking Garage: The City of Bethlehem has a covered parking deck on North St., about 5 blocks from campus. Through an arrangement with the Parking Authority and Moravian Students, including freshman, may purchase a parking pass to use the facility. The Parking Authority can be reached at 610-865-7123, to purchase a pass. Payment can be made by Cash, Check, or Money Order. **The City Parking pass does not allow you to park on campus property or with in a half mile of campus.** The Moravian College bus will stop at the garage on its regular run between North Campus and Hurd Church St. Campus. You must show College I.D. to get on the bus.

Violations of the policy will result in sanctions imposed by the Department of Campus Safety and Police including tickets, fines, and/or suspension of parking privileges during the present and/or future term(s).
